How to get to the Coach and Horses at Markfield

The Coach and Horses is conveniently situated a few minutes away from the M1 at junction 22

Approaching from the South

Leave the M1 at junction 22 and take the 4th exit from the roundabout signed for A50 Leicester. Follow the dual carriage way to the first roundabout.

Approaching from the North

Leave the M1 at Junction 22 and take the first exit from the roundabout onto the A50 signed for Leicester. Follow the dual carriage way to the first roundabout.

Approaching from the West along the A511

At the junction of the A511 and the M1 – take the second exit from the roundabout signed A50 Leicester. Follow the dual carriage way to the first roundabout.

At the first roundabout

At the first roundabout take the 3rd exit signed Ratby. Follow the road for about a ¼ mile and take the second turning on the left into Ratby Lane. Follow this road and just before you meet the main road take a sharp turn left and follow the lane – you will see the Coach and Horses Pub in front of you and car parking is available at the front and side of the pub.

Approaching along the A50 from Leicester

As you approach Markfield you will be travelling uphill on a dual carriage way as you reach the brow of the hill you will see the Coach and Horses on left hand side. Turn left off the dual carriage way onto the service road immediately before the pedestrian crossing to get to the Coach and Horses. If you miss the turn – continue to the roundabout, take the first exit and follow the instructions above.

Public Transport

There are train stations at Burton on Trent, Leicester and Loughborough. Taxis are available at all stations.

There is a regular bus service passes the pub between Leicester and Coalville operated by Arriva. You should get off the bus at Field Head, not Markfield.

Accommodation

There are a number of low cost hotels in the vicinity of the Coach and Horses. The Field Head Hotel is just across the road from the Coach and Horses and offers full facilities. There are Travelodges at Junction 22 and 23a. There is a Days Inn at Leicester Forest East Services and the Charnwood Arms at Bardon also has a number of rooms.
